The international civilian observers have patrolled the streets of Hebron for almost twenty years. Their job is to provide Palestinians with a sense of security by reporting violence and abuse. But their reports are confidential. There is increasing frustration that the parties fail to deal with the problems the observers have highlighted for so many years. We join the observers on patrol in one of the world's most conflict-ridden areas.

Accompanied by his teenage daughter, nature photographer Tom returns to the mysterious mountain he explored as a child. With his camera we visit caves, plumb crevasses, discover fabled animals and enter labyrinths with walls decoratively patterned by Nature herself. Tom grew up in the shadow of the mountain, Mt Glom, a marble peak honeycombed with caverns. Here he used to hunt for exotic beasts that included coiled serpents concealed in the cave walls, fanciful creatures brought vividly to life by the imagination of a child.

Does prosperity equals humanism? Filipino au pairs are exploited by quite a few Norwegian families. The au pairs and the family sign a contract that explicitly states that the girls are in Norway on cultural exchange. The contract has clear guidelines for pay and working hours, and emphasizes that the au pair shall be part of the family. But within their own homes, the families ignore these contracts and treat the girls as the family's servants. Many are kept from going outside, their passports are taken, and if they don't do as the host family says, they threaten to send them home. In "Masters and Servants" we follow 27-year-old Christy, who has filed charges against her former host family for human trafficking.

Over 50.000 people in Denmark get ill from food consumption every year. "Razzia" follow The Danish food ministry as they travel across the country to localize the sources of food condemnation. The financial government strikes to reveal private persons who cheat on their taxes, and organizations that bend the rules.



The largest mountain plateau in Europe with Norway's biggest stock of wild reindeer and rich bird and animal life and varied flora. The Hardanger Plateau is the highest mountain plateau in Europe. In 1981, 3,500 sq. km of the plateau were designated a national park - the biggest in Norway - on condition that the area's natural resources should remain open to utilization as before. The boundaries of the park were largely determined by the local lakes and rivers, whose power is of great economic value - though at a price. Much of the park is private property, the rest being state-owned commonland on which the local population has prior right to hunt and fish.



Now, however, the park, the National September 11 Memorial & Museum, is open to the public and the remaining building work is nearing completion. This film tells the story of the process from start to finish.


